



Hells Gates

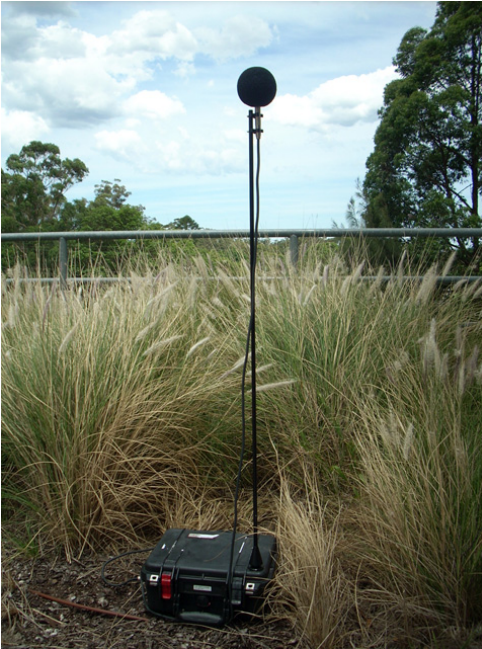


A range of field surveys will be undertaken for the Hells Gates Project to document the current environmental conditions across the project area. These studies will be supplemented by desktop assessment of existing information. The results will inform the Business Case and environmental assessment.

NOISE MONITORING

If determined to be necessary based on desktop review and modelling, noise monitoring may be conducted to determine the existing background noise in the project area. This would be done using a logger in appropriate protective housing to collect data over a period of time.

If undertaken, noise monitoring loggers would be placed near 'sensitive receptors' such as residential dwellings that are in proximity to potential project infrastructure and/or works.

Consultation

All field investigations will be undertaken in consultation with landholders. Specific measures which ensure there will be no effect on landholder operations and activities will be identified through engaging with landholders and enshrined in the Project Land Access Protocol. All field work will be conducted in accordance with landholder requests and consider the location of sampling sites, how these sites are to be access and the timing of access.
